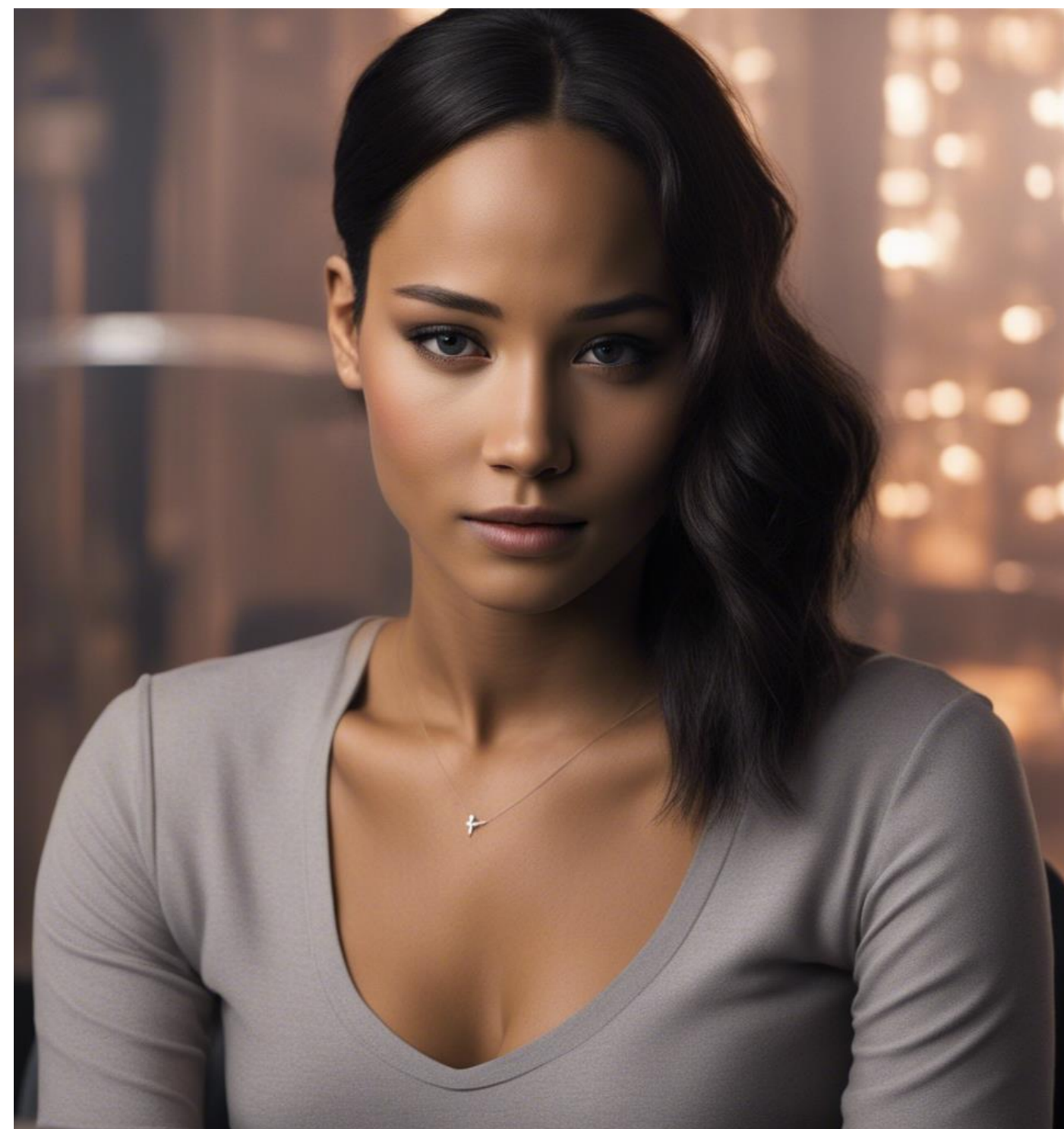


Celebrity stories
